Background to the project

This was our third year of running workshops as part of Feast. We felt that it was a great opportunity to work with Malvern Priory as part of the outreach work of the Feast Festival.

The workshop was advertised as part of the Festival's marketing and the bookings came from personal contact from Crave Arts as well as Feast.

The Priory were keen that we used their building and were kind enough not to charge us for the space.

We were keen to have another writer with us and were delighted when Tiffany Hoskins from Reaction Theatre put us in touch with the Worcestershire Poet Sarah Leavesley. From early discussions it was clear that Sarah was going to be a real asset for the workshop.



The Workshop

Six people attended on the day. This was a little lower than we hoped but gave us time to listen more to the writers and give more detailed feedback.

Steve and Sarah planned the workshop meticulously. The day itself consisted of writing games and exercises with plenty of time for the writers to both listen and also respond to the various prompts. Steve and Sarah gave individual exercises but also worked together on joint activity. We also had a tour of the Priory by one of the guides which was especially inspiring and got us talking about faith as well as looking at some of the individual features of the building.

Tea and Coffee flowed throughout the day.
Writers were given time to write in more depth and the day finished with readings from the writers. All of the six attendees wrote something on the day and we finished the day with discussions about career development and writing opportunities.
